The MAIN ROW (B3:E3)

This algorithm determines how many extra occurrences of a given number there are in two compared rows besides matching blacks.

It does this by first determining how many extra occurrences of a number there are in the master row minus the matching blacks, and then determining how many of that number there are in the second row besides matching blacks. By taking the minimum of these two results, one gets the quantity of extra occurrences of the number that are in both rows.

This algorithm uses two Excel functions COUNTIF and COUNTIFS:

COUNTIF – receives a range of cells and compares it with a value. Then it returns the number of times it finds that value among the cells it checked. In this application, we are counting the number of times the number that was guessed occurs in a row of four cells.

COUNTIFS – this is very much like COUNTIF, except that COUNTIFS makes the comparison of multiple COUNTIF's and returns the number of times all of the comparisons are true. (In other words, COUNTIFS does an AND of multiple COUNTIF's.)
